# FAMILY CATECHESIS

- The program is based on family catechesis and therefore depends on the family's participation for a student to succeed.
- Queen defines family as the student and parents and siblings living in the household. If the family cannot participate in a Family Faith Formation Session, Devotional practices or Service activity, than at least one parent must accompany the student and participate with the student in the activity.
- Parents of other students enrolled in the program *DO NOT* meet this definition and may not serve as a substitute.



# REQUIRED PARTICIPATION

- The program requires three components: faith formation, devotional practices, and service.
  - Faith formation includes 6 Sunday morning sessions beginning at 9:45 a.m. and ending in time for 11:30 a.m. mass
  - Devotional practices includes Sunday mass, Reconciliation twice a year, attendance at special church events (Lessons & Carols, Living Stations etc.)
  - Service in one or more of our church ministries
- All requirements for each component must be fully met for a student to be eligible for promotion at the end of the program year.
- It is the parents' responsibility to make sure that they and the students fulfill the program requirements.



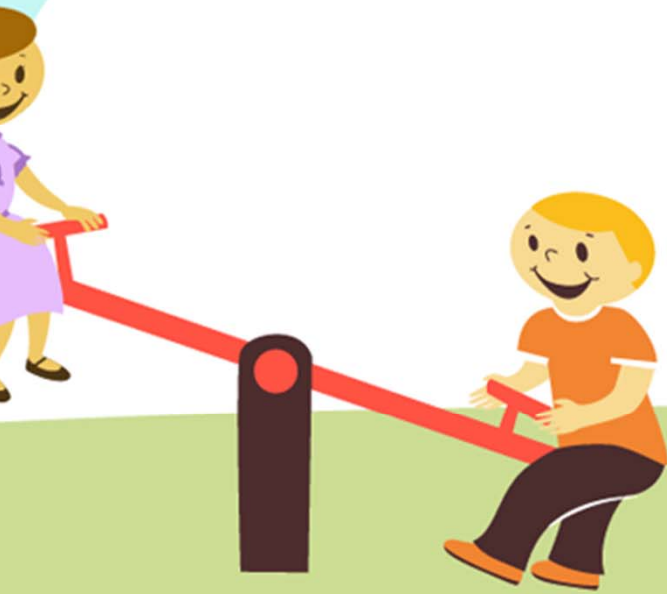
# FAMILY REQUIREMENTS

- Weekly participation at Mass and Holy Days of Obligation
- Interactive involvement in the “Bible Question of the Week”
- Strongly recommend participation in the Sacrament of Reconciliation twice a year
- Family participation in one Church Ministry



# Forty Hour Program

- 25 hours – Grade Level Instruction – Monday, June \_\_ through Friday, June \_\_ (8:30 a.m. – 2 p.m.)- Dates TBD.
- 10 hours – 6 Family Catechesis & Grade Level follow-up (September 2016 – May 2017)
- 5 hours – Devotional Practices (i.e. 40 Hours, Lessons and Carols, Holy Week, Stations of the Cross, Living Stations)



# Sacramental Years

- Students eligible to begin sacramental preparation for First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion or Confirmation will be expected to attend the Presentation Mass, the Retreats and the rehearsals.
- Parents will attend the Family Faith Formation and Informational meetings for each sacrament.
