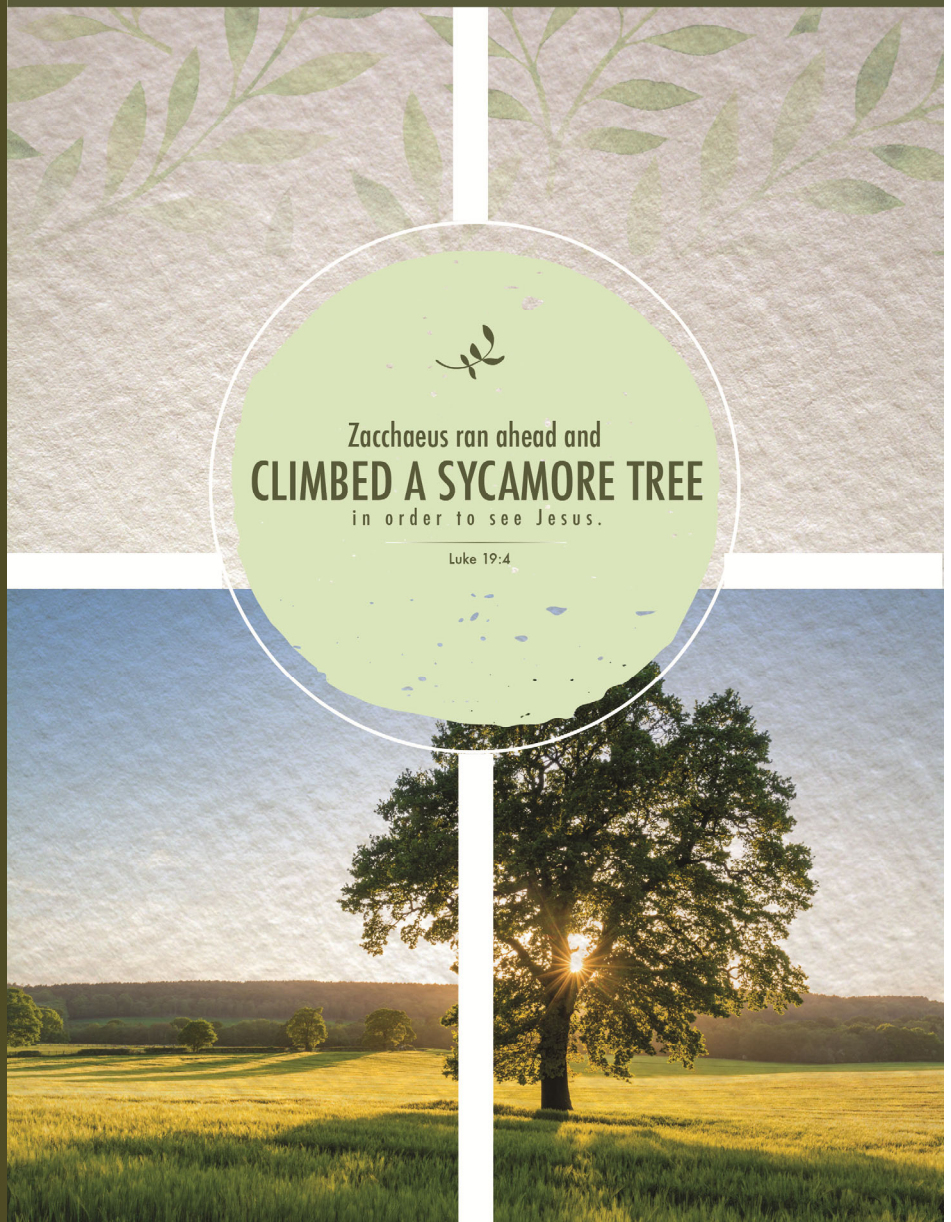

### CONFIDENCE IN THE LORD

We are nearing the end of the liturgical year. Today's readings remind us that our own lives will draw to a close one day, and we can be certain that the Lord will encourage, strengthen, and save us—both now and at the last. The astonishing story of the Maccabees invigorates our faith as we behold an entire family willing to die rather than deny the Law of Moses. The psalm response echoes the faithful cries of the Maccabees: "I call upon you, for you will answer me, O God." That same confidence appears in Saint Paul's letter to the Thessalonians. "The Lord is faithful," he testifies; "he will strengthen you and guard you from the evil one." In the Gospel, Jesus explains just how long God's protection will endure. The children of God whom God guards, Jesus says, will live forever like angels.

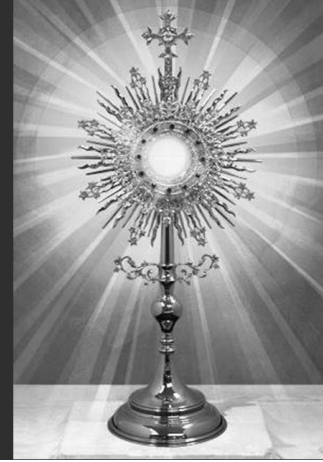

**Cross Train Your Faith**

This week, Matthew Leonard takes us through Lessons 9 and 10 of **"Genesis to Jesus."**

In Lesson 9 **"Riser of the Covenant Kingdom,"** the themes to be covered are:

- Israel enters the Promised Land
- Israel asks for a king
- The fall of King Saul
- The rise of King David and his role as a priest-king
- Jesus as the "New David"

The events in Exodus, including the role of Moses as a deliverer, foreshadow the person and work of Jesus Christ. Jesus is born under a murderous king who slays Hebrew baby boys, just as Moses was. Jesus undergoes a period of exile in Egypt until the Lord calls him back to his homeland, just as Israel did, along with a number of other prophetic situations which Matthew Leonard describes.

In Lesson 10 **"Features of the Kingdom,"** the themes to be covered are:

- The primary and secondary features of the Davidic kingdom
- The **todah** or thanksgiving offering
- The sin of David
- The failures and fall of Solomon and his kingdom
- The restoration of the kingdom prophetically foretold

David is not only a king; he also performs the services of a priest – he wears a Levitical garment; he brings the Ark of the Covenant into Jerusalem in a liturgical procession, and performs other priestly functions.

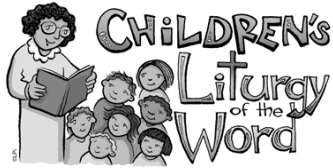

## AROUND THE ARCHDIOCESE

### **Presentation: What Can We Do? The Role of the Laity in a Time of Crisis**

As the Church undergoes this period of profound crisis, many of us feel helpless as we watch a drama unfold that we can do nothing about. But the truth is that we are not powerless. The history of the Church tells us that lay people have a role to play in the Church's times of turmoil. 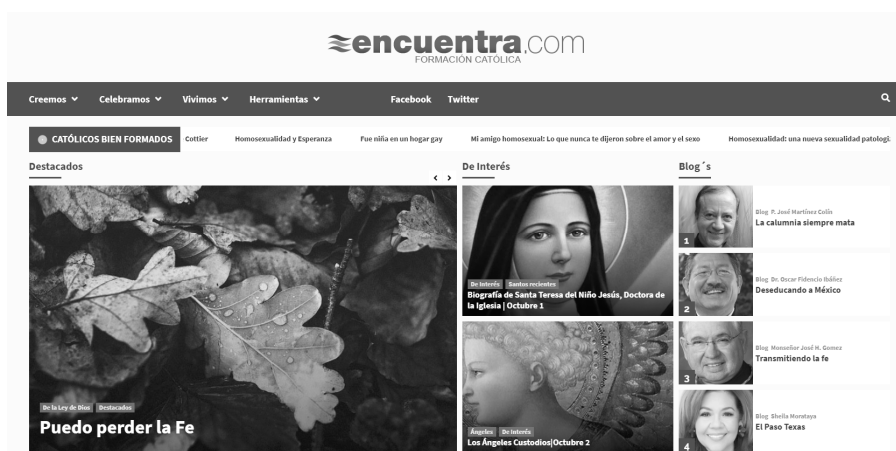
