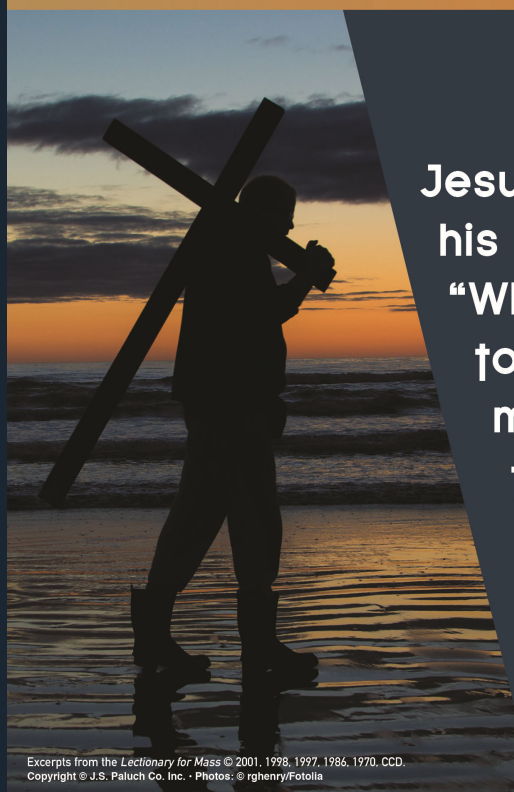

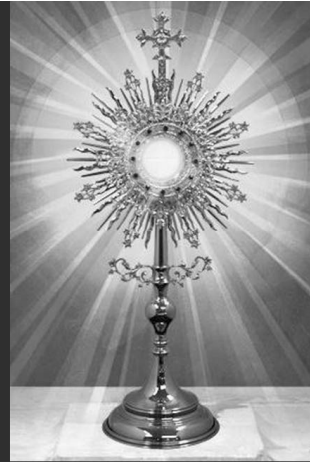

## HOLY FAMILY REG. CATHOLIC SCH.

**Holy Family Regional Catholic School is preparing for the 2020-2021 school year in ways as never before!** The COVID-19 pandemic has had an impact on education beginning in March, when the mandated shutdown forced everyone to stay at home and virtual learning became the new norm. Holy Family did not miss a beat; the school building closed on Friday, March 13, and virtual learning began on Monday, March 16. Our school finished the new year with amazing innovation – we had a virtual Spirit Day (field day), virtual prayer service, even our Student Council elections were done virtually! If necessity is indeed the mother of invention, then Holy Family embraced creativity in meeting the needs of our students!

This summer, planning for the reopening of school has taken on a whole new meaning. Regulations and protocols from the Pennsylvania Department of Education, the Bucks County Department of Health and The Office of Catholic Education provided guidance for our own Reopening Plan that was shared with our stakeholders last week. Our school will be opening with in-person learning as well as virtual learning. Based on our parent survey that was completed in July, we have families interested in both our in-person and virtual options.

While our virtual learning that occurred in the spring went very well, we are now offering live streaming synchronous learning. This means that our students who are learning from home will log in virtually to their classroom and will learn at the same time as their peers who are learning in the classroom. This way our teachers will be able to respond to their students both in person and virtual in real time.

In addition to all of the planning for virtual learning, which includes the purchase of the necessary live streaming equipment and upgrading our network bandwidth, we are also planning for the health and safety of our students and faculty who will be learning in the school building. All our students and faculty will be wearing masks while in the building and the classroom. Our classrooms are being restructured to include only the essentials, and student desks are being positioned to be as socially distant as space allows. Each student desk will have an individual sneeze guard protector. Signage and posters with reminders of proper safety protocol are being placed around the building. Hand sanitizing stations will be located at the two entrances we will be using this year – the main front door and the bus depot door. We are creating outdoor recess “zones” for each homeroom to use while outside that affords proper distancing from other classrooms. Students will be staying in their homeroom for most of the day, with special subject teachers coming to the classroom to eliminate excessive movement in the hallways.

Ultimately, whether students are learning in the classroom or from home, our goal is to provide the best Catholic school education for our students.

**As we begin this school year, we are counting on the prayers of all our stakeholders, especially our parishioners from St. Frances Cabrini and Queen of the Universe parishes.** Your prayerful support will enable us to venture forward in faith in pursuing our mission to inspire, challenge and nurture those students in our care.
