## MASK REQUIREMENT REMINDER

### Mask Reminders

Per Archdiocesan and CDC guidelines, **masks must be worn in order to enter the church.** While face shields may also be worn, they must be used with a mask and should not replace a mask. Recent studies show that a significant portion of individuals with COVID-19 lack symptoms (are “asymptomatic”) and that even those who eventually develop symptoms (are “pre-symptomatic”) can transmit the virus to others before showing symptoms.

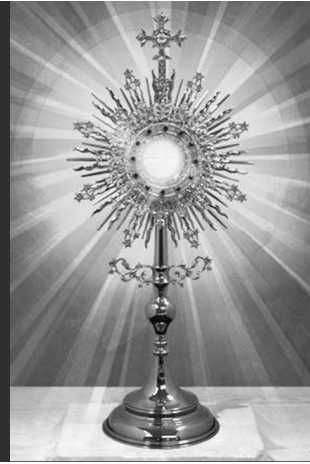
