MARRIAGES:

Archdiocesan Regulations require that notice of intended marriage be made six months prior to the date of the marriage. Pre-nuptial instructions are required for marriage. Contact the Rectory for location.

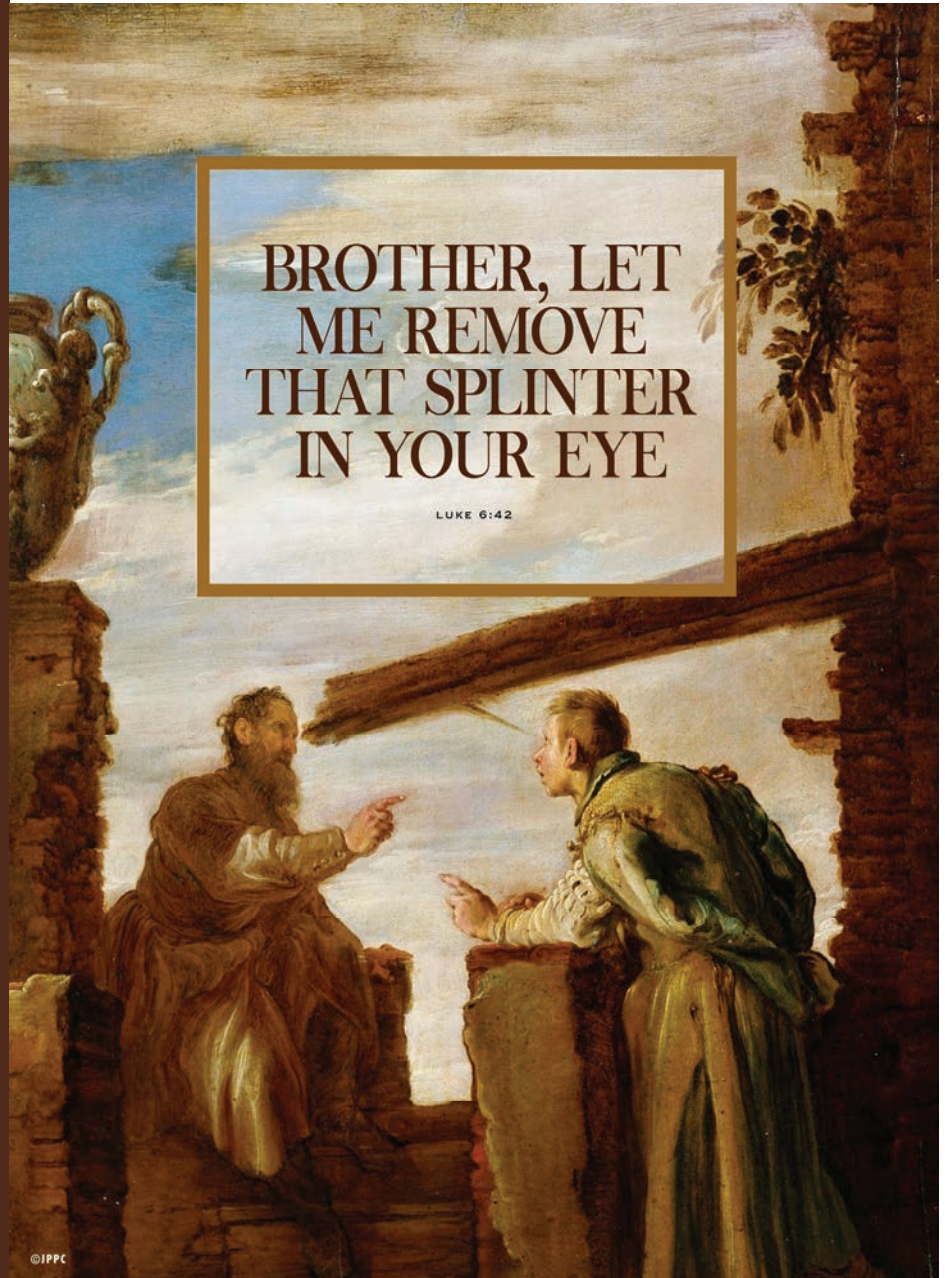

BY THE WAY

Dear Sisters and Brothers,
The Holy Season of Lent begins this Wednesday, March 2, with the Celebration of Ash Wednesday. Mass, with the imposition of ash, will take place at 8:30 am, 12:00 noon, 7:00 pm and 8:30 pm (Spanish Mass). This external symbol, a cross on our forehead, shows the world who we are. We are Christians. We are friends of Jesus. Even when that cross is not visible on our foreheads, all our words and actions should show the world we are Christians! Do they? Lent is the time to look deep into ourselves, and change what needs to be changed in order to be a more vibrant reflection of Christ in the world. With God's grace we can do this.

The Stations of the Cross are an ancient tradition where we journey with Jesus as he carried his Cross through the streets of Jerusalem. We will pray the Stations of the Cross on Friday's at 5:30 pm. Also, on Thursday's we have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament after the 8:30 Mass and ending with Benediction at 5:00. Look to the bulletin for many other opportunities to grow in our prayer life this Lent.

A great companion on our Lenten journey is The Little Black Book. Use it each day to help you journey closely with Jesus this Lent. Operation Rise Bowl supports the good works of Catholic Relief Services. The books and rice bowls can be found at the entrances of the Church.

Guidelines for Fasting and Abstinence during Lent:
Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of **fasting and abstinence** for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

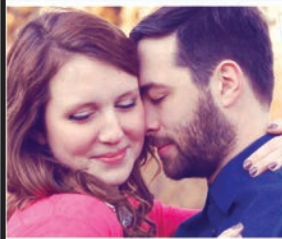



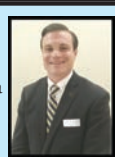
